9) I can add suffixes to spell longer words, including –ment, –ness, –ful, –less, –ly, –er, –est (EXS)			
10) I can use a range of spelling rules taught at Year 2.			
11) I can write the correct spellings and punctuation in simple sentences I hear my teacher say.

13) I can write lower-case letters that are all the same size in most of my writing.

16) I can write capital letters and numbers the right way up, the correct size relative to each other and lower case letters. (EXS)
