Word Reading		
1) Develop their phonological awareness so that they can: spot and suggest rhymes		
2) Count or clap syllables in a word		
3) Recognize words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother		
Comprehension		
4) Understand the five key concepts about print: print has meaning		
5) Print can have different purposes		
6) We read English from left to right and from top to bottom		
7) The names of the different parts of a book		
8) Page sequencing		
9) Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

Composition		
10) Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; writing 'm' for mummy.		
11) Write some letters correctly
