We hope that you and your child were able to read the books sent out at the end of last term and were able to learn more about what we will be teaching this year.



We have had positive feedback from some parents which led to days out and research into the topics.

If you have not already done so, please return the books to school with your child as they will be using them as a learning resource.

School Fund - School Fund is £3.00 per term, this can be paid via your online account.

PE days - children will be required to come to school in their PE/outdoor kit on the following days:

Year 1 - Friday

Year 2 - Wednesday

Year 3 - Thursday

Year 4 - Wednesday

Year 5 – Tuesday

Year 6 – Monday

PE kit should be a plain t-shirt in your child’s house colour and dark green shorts and black pumps. Children may wear a school green tracksuit on these days, available from Myclothing.com and Kidscorner. Alternatively, plain black jogging bottoms (no writing or logos), black sweatshirt or their school sweatshirt. Plain black trainers may be worn. Please ensure that all earrings are removed for PE days.

Water Bottles - Please send your child into school with a clear plastic water bottle with your child’s name on. Please do not send flavoured water or squash into school unless as part of a packed lunch.

If your child has any of these 3 coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, even if mild, please book a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test for them as soon as possible:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- Loss of or change to their sense of smell or taste

They will need to isolate until negative result of PCR test is received (Lateral Flow test results will not be accepted as an alternative)

If children present with symptoms at school you will be contacted to collect them and arrange a PCR test before they can return. (it is essential that we have up to date contact numbers in the event of an emergency)

IN ADDITION, DUE TO HIGH CASE LEVELS IN THE CITY, THE PUBLIC HEALTH TEAM HAVE ADVISED SCHOOLS....

that any pupil unwell enough not to attend school for any illness (even if not a typical Covid symptom) also accesses a PCR test or not attend school for 48 hours after symptoms stop.

PE Kit	Coloured t-shirt (house colour) Red/ Blue / Yellow /Black <input type="checkbox"/> Dark green shorts <input type="checkbox"/> Black pumps <input type="checkbox"/> Dark green track suit may be worn in winter (available from Kids Corner)
Bags in school	A flat nylon book bag in green (black if green has limited availability) , is recommended for children to carry books and letters home. These bags are available for purchase from Kids' Corner or myclothing.com . These will be the only bags that the children will be allowed in school. Other bags will be sent home.
Footwear	If boots or trainers are worn to school, then a change of footwear will be necessary for wear during the school day. Trainers can be worn at playtimes or dinner times but must be changed to school shoes in the classroom. Wellington boots will be needed in school everyday for Reception children.
School Meals	Please pay in advance using your Sims Pay account if your child/ren will be having a school meal.
Packed lunches	School is an ideal setting to promote healthy lifestyles and therefore we have the following requirements for packed lunches: <input type="checkbox"/> No sweets – a small fun sized chocolate/biscuit may be included as part of a balanced meal. <input type="checkbox"/> Drinks may include fruit juice, flavoured water or milk based drinks. Fizzy drinks are not allowed. <input type="checkbox"/> Nuts - please refrain from sending these items as some pupils have allergies which may be life threatening.
Water	All pupils are encouraged to bring a bottle into school each day that can be filled with water. This should be a clear plastic bottle and labelled with your child's name. Water bottles are available from the school office to purchase. Please do not send flavoured water or squash into school. Wood End has a water only policy during school.
Earrings/ Jewellery and Make Up	In the interests of safety, jewellery should not be worn in school as it can be hazardous in some lessons. Pupils who have pierced ears may only wear small plain studs (not novelty earrings) but these need to be removed during PE and swimming lessons. If earrings are worn on PE days, and your child cannot remove them themselves, they will be covered by tape by a member of staff. Make up and nail varnish must not be worn in school. Nail varnish will be removed by a member of school staff. Small watches may be worn in school by pupils who are able to tell the time. If worn, watches will also need to be removed for PE and swimming lessons.
