Dear Parents

Lockdown measures began across the country yesterday. School will continue to be open during this period. Measures put in place in September are still required. You must let us know if your child has symptoms or has a positive test result.

In addition, from Monday 9th November we will require...

- Adults dropping off and collecting children to wear a face mask when coming through the school gates onto school premises. (This will help people from other households to pass you safely).
- Avoid giving messages to staff on gate. If the message is essential please maintain a distance.
- Do not bring messages / forms to the office between 8:30 and 8:55am or 3pm and 3:20pm

Thank you to all parents in year 1 who supported us in closing their bubble quickly by arranging to collect children at short notice. We appreciate this can be difficult and are grateful for this support in keeping children safe.

The majority of year 1 children were also able to access learning remotely including live lessons - thank you for your support and patience with this.

We hope that all families across the school have been able to download the Microsoft Teams app to enable your child to engage with online learning, as requested in the last newsletter. We will be sending log in details out shortly. Please keep these details safe.
