You will see them:	<p>Explain how some teachings and beliefs are shared between religions.</p> <p>Explain how religious beliefs shape the lives of individuals and communities.</p> <p>Explain the practices and lifestyles involved in belonging to a faith community.</p> <p>Compare and contrast the lifestyles of different faith groups and give reasons why some within the same faith may adopt different lifestyles.</p> <p>Show an understanding of the role of a spiritual leader.</p> <p>Explain some of the different ways that individuals show their beliefs.</p> <p>Recognise and express feelings about their own identities. Relate these to religious beliefs or teachings.</p> <p>Explain their own ideas about the answers to ultimate questions.</p> <p>Explain why their own answers to ultimate questions may differ from those of others.</p> <p>Explain why different religious communities or individuals may have a different view of what is right and wrong.</p> <p>Show an awareness of morals and right and wrong beyond rules (i.e. wanting to act in a certain way despite rules).</p> <p>Express their own values and remain respectful of those with different values.</p>
