

# Music in Key Stage One



<b>Pupils will:</b>	Use voices expressively and creatively Play tuned and untuned instruments musically. Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music.
<b>You will see them:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Take part in singing, accurately following the melody.</li><li>• Follow instructions on how and when to sing or play an instrument.</li><li>• Make and control long and short sounds, using voice and instruments.</li><li>• Imitate changes in pitch.</li><li>• Create a sequence of long and short sounds.</li><li>• Clap rhythms.</li><li>• Create a mixture of different sounds (long and short, loud and quiet, high and low).</li><li>• Choose sounds to create an effect.</li><li>• Sequence sounds to create an overall effect.</li><li>• Create short, musical patterns.</li><li>• Create short, rhythmic phrases.</li><li>• Use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance.</li><li>• Identify the beat of a tune.</li><li>• Recognise changes in timbre, dynamics and pitch.</li></ul>
